Mr. Naik Receives Padma Bhushan from President of India

Mr. A. M. Naik, Chairman & Managing Director, received a high civilian honour – the Padma Bhushan – from the President of India, Mrs. Pratibha Patil on March 31, 2009. The awards ceremony was held within the magnificent precincts of the Rashtrapati Bhawan in Delhi.
