

L&T bags ` .716 Cr Infrastructure order in UAE

Mumbai, December 3, 2010: Larsen & Toubro's (L&T) Infrastructure Operating Company, part of its Construction Division, has made a major breakthrough in the international infrastructure segment by bagging an AED 592 Million (approx. ` .716 crore) major contract for the construction of a 12 km long, 12-lane main road linking the two emirates.

To be completed in 24 months, the project involves construction of 12 km of 12-lane main road with spans and multi-cells (from 2 to 8 in-situ box girders); one single cell voided slab and 12 km of 4 to 6 lane roads with including associated electrical, water and drainage network and irrigation. Set to meet the highest International standards, the project will significantly improve traffic conditions in the Al Samha area from the new Sheikh Khalifa port.
